






# High School Dress Code

Students are not required to wear uniform in the High School years (H1 to H4). However, as students are ambassadors of the school and the High School is a purposeful and professional centre of learning, as well as for health and safety reasons, certain standards are necessary and must be adhered to. All students are required to meet the expectations below. Should students choose to wear clothing deemed unsuitable (e.g. too revealing), they will be required to change clothes. If students persistently disregard the Dress Code, parents will be contacted, sanctions issued as per our behaviour procedures.

<p>Hair</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Unnatural hair dye must be discreet and not the whole head.</li> <li>- No mohicans or extreme hairstyles</li> <li>- Must be well kept</li> <li>- Must be tied back during PE and Science practicals</li> </ul>
<p>Hoodies/Hats</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Can be worn when travelling to school and outdoors but not indoors during school hours/lessons</li> </ul>

<p>Piercings</p> 	<p>Unacceptable</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Must be able to be removable for sports and activities</li> <li>- Must be safe and discreet</li> </ul> <p>Facial piercings must be studs</p>
<p>Tattoos</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- No tattoos showing</li> </ul>

Should students be required to wear certain clothing or jewellery for religious reasons a letter must be sent to the relevant head of year explaining the situation.
